










Reception Homework- Autumn Term 1

Counting to 5 each time.</p> 
<p>Go on a nature walk with your family. What can you see? What can you hear? What can you smell? Draw a picture of your favourite thing.</p> 	<p>Find numbers to 5 around the house. Write them down. Can you count out objects to match? Can you order them from smallest to greatest?</p> 	<p>Paint a picture of your family. Talk about who is in your family and where you live.</p> 
<p>Practise your cutting skills with an adult. Can you cut around some pictures from an old magazine or newspaper?</p> 	<p>Sing a range of nursery rhymes and perform them to your family.
