Please try to complete one activity per week and return books to school on Monday.

Please continue to complete Numbots and daily reading at home and record this in your child's reading diary.

Make a paper plate clock to practise telling the time, focussing on o'clock and half past.	Look at some coins together at home, talk about how much each coin is worth. Can you set up your own shop to sell some items using the coins, using 1ps, 2ps, 5ps and 10ps.	Set up a miniature obstacle course. See if you can challenge yourself to move in different directions and follow instructions to move 'forwards', 'backwards', 'left' and 'right'.
Tell us all about your favourite place to visit- can you make a leaflet to convince us to go?	Share with us somewhere special you have been that is not in Cornwall. Upload a video to Tapestry, telling us all about it.	Listen to the story:
Make a car using junk materials. Test it out and share photos with us.	Reflect on your time in Year One so far. Write some questions about your transition to Year Two.	Practise learning a new skill and share with us. It could be skipping, riding a bike, swimming or anything you like. Share with us how you get on.
