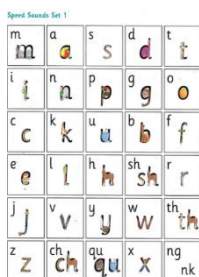


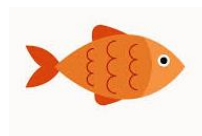
Reception Summer 1 Homework

Please spend some time practising letter formation at home. Please use the RWI sound mat provided at the beginning of the year to make sure you start in the right place and use the correct rhyme to support you.

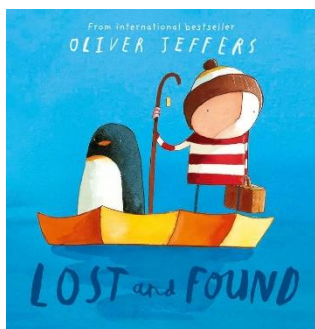

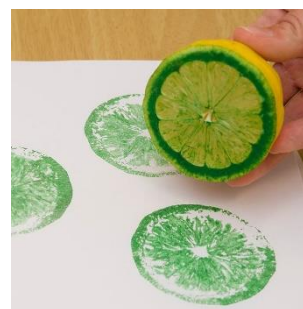
