Measure their capacity in litres and millilitres. Are there any surprises? Does a long thin vase hold more than a wide deep bowl?</p>
<p>Make a poster to remind people how to keep themselves healthy.</p>  <p>Remember a healthy mind and a healthy body are both important.</p>	<p>Find three different objects in your home. Use scales to measure their mass in grams or kilograms. Order them from smallest to largest.</p> 	 <p>Visit a church. Look at the images and statues inside.
