Make a paper plate clock to practise telling the time, focussing on o'clock and half past.	Look at some coins together at home, talk about how much each coin is worth. Can you set up your own shop to sell some items using the coins, using 1ps, 2ps, 5ps and 10ps.	Set up a miniature obstacle course. See if you can challenge yourself to move in different directions and follow instructions to move 'forwards', 'backwards', 'left' and 'right'.
Tell us all about your pet or your favourite animal. Is it a fish, amphibian, reptile, bird or mammal? Can you tell us about their diet?	Talk about how we keep fit and healthy, create a poster to tell others how they can keep healthy.	Listen to and learn the story 'Monkey puzzle.' (This will be shared on Tapestry in Week 4)
Read and find out some facts about animals in a non-fiction book.	Reflect on your time in year one so far. Write down any questions that you may have about your transition to year two.	Retell a favourite story about an animal, can you make some changes to the story to make it your own?
Create some artwork of an unusual animal.	Make some number cards choosing some numbers to 100. Can you place them in order from smallest to greatest? Can you record how many tens and how many ones some of your numbers have?	Go on a walk to search for some amazing animals. Take some photographs to share with us what you find.
