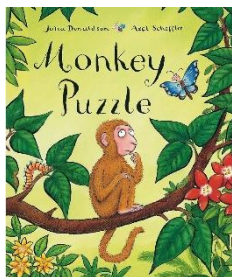
Please spend some time practising letter formation at home. Please ensure they have tall long letters and their descender sit below the line.

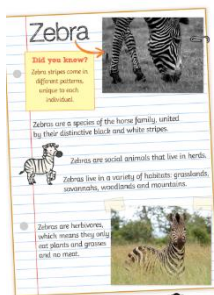
