This may be a combination of white rose maths videos (the scheme used to support lessons in school), the PowerPoints shared in the classroom and resources/worksheets used in the classroom. Answers will be provided for self-marking at home.</li> <li>English uploaded to Tapestry following the sequence of learning happening in the classroom. The quantity will be dependent on age/year of your child. Some/all of these will be 'handed in' to your child's class teacher on Tapestry for marking. English tasks will consist of Reading, Writing and Phonics and activities in line with the class timetable.</li> <li>Topic task(s) following the lessons being covered in class that week. This may be the screens from the lesson being uploaded onto Tapestry along with resources / worksheets. If the lessons being taught in class are not able to be delivered remotely (e.g. if it requires additional resources such as art resources e.g. clay or pastels, or geography resources e.g. maps and atlases) then</li> </ul>			

<sup>\*</sup> the video learning sessions will not be facilitated by your child's class teacher if the teacher is the one experiencing Covid symptoms and the reason for the bubble closure. We know our parents will understand that the health and wellbeing of our children, families and staff is paramount.

OR  We enter another 'lockdown' with total school closure.	<ul> <li>Video Learning/Support* – this will look different depending on the age of the children. This will be a short video session delivered by the class teacher and uploaded onto Tapestry. These will be spread across the week focusing on some focus lessons.</li> <li>1:1 support if your child receives 1:1 support, a more bespoke programme of support will be set up and sent to you. This may include phone calls with your child's class teacher and if necessary the SENDco. They will usually be expected to still complete the learning set on Tapestry as appropriate.</li> <li>Feedback will be more bespoke to individuals to identify any misconceptions and address these. This will be delivered via Tapestry.</li> <li>Tapestry: Class Message weekly – this will include a teacher message and stomation of power service of the week's learning spint of days for reading, writing and maths will be posted by 3pm on a Friday afternoon. This planning will contain links to online videos as appropriate.</li> <li>Resources – resources to support learning will be posted on Tapestry. These will be combination of powerpoints and worksheets (kept to a minimum). Some short video explanations will be provided by the class teachers as appropriate.</li> </ul>	

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
